Welcome to KarupKølvrå Children's House.

Soon, your child will start in the nursery, and in this folder, you will find relevant information regarding the start in the room called "Mejserne" (the Tits).

Wardrobe, outdoor clothes, spare clothes, and diapers.

Your child will be assigned a wardrobe space, where it is expected that there is clothing suitable for the season and weather conditions. It is a great help for both adults and children if you hang out clothes that fit the weather. For example, if it's raining, please hang the rain gear out so it doesn't have to be found in bags. This also allows for working on the child's independence. It is also expected that there are several sets of spare clothes in case of accidents or if the child gets wet, so he/she can continue with the daily routine. If your child has changed clothes, these will be hung in a bag in the room, which should be taken home that day. Every Friday, both indoor and outdoor clothing should be taken home from the wardrobe so that it can be replenished for the following week. During the week, we will put up signs by your child's wardrobe if there is a need for spare clothes. Please remember to label all of your child's belongings. We will also post signs if there is a shortage of diapers, as these need to be provided from home. We recommend bringing one pack at a time, as they are used up quickly.

Aula

All communication takes place through Aula. However, if something urgent arises, it is possible to call or be called back from the number 87871535. Please enter your phone numbers in Aula so we can contact you if your child becomes ill or gets injured. Generally, we prefer important information and messages to be sent to the contact educator or all staff in the Mejserne room via a thread on Aula. In Aula, you should enter arrival and departure times every day so we can create the best day for your child. Here you also enter who will pick up your child so we know who to hand the child over

to. If your child is sick or staying home, this should also be noted in Aula. This is also where we update with pictures taken throughout the day of what we are doing.

Facts about the opening and meal times of the Children's House.

The Children's House opens every weekday at 6:15 AM and closes at 4:35 PM from Monday to Thursday. On Fridays, the Children's House closes at 3:30 PM. We operate as a shared space in the morning and afternoon. From 6:15 AM to 7:15 AM, breakfast is served. Once breakfast ends, the Mejserne group goes down to the nursery. From 9:00 AM to 9:30 AM, we have a morning snack. From 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM, we engage in activities with the children. Currently, there is a focus on "We Learn Together" in Viborg Municipality, so we plan activities based on this. From 11:00 AM to 11:30 AM, we have lunch, after which we put the children down for a nap. After the nap, afternoon snacks are served. Menu cards are posted on bulletin boards by the check-in screens, so you can keep track of what is served to the children each week. We use kitchen cups for morning and lunch meals. For the afternoon snack, please bring your own water bottles, which should be taken home each day as they are not cleaned at the facility. Regarding birthdays, we would like to remind you of our no-sugar policy. If you are unsure about what to bring, please ask the staff in the room or the kitchen.

Transitioning your child

We recommend starting the transition gradually, where you as parents leave the facility for longer periods, allowing your child to adjust to being here independently. The start date will be arranged with your child's contact educator. Feel free to ask any questions you may have, including those that come up along the way. You are also always welcome to request a meeting with your contact educator if needed. We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to Mejserne.
